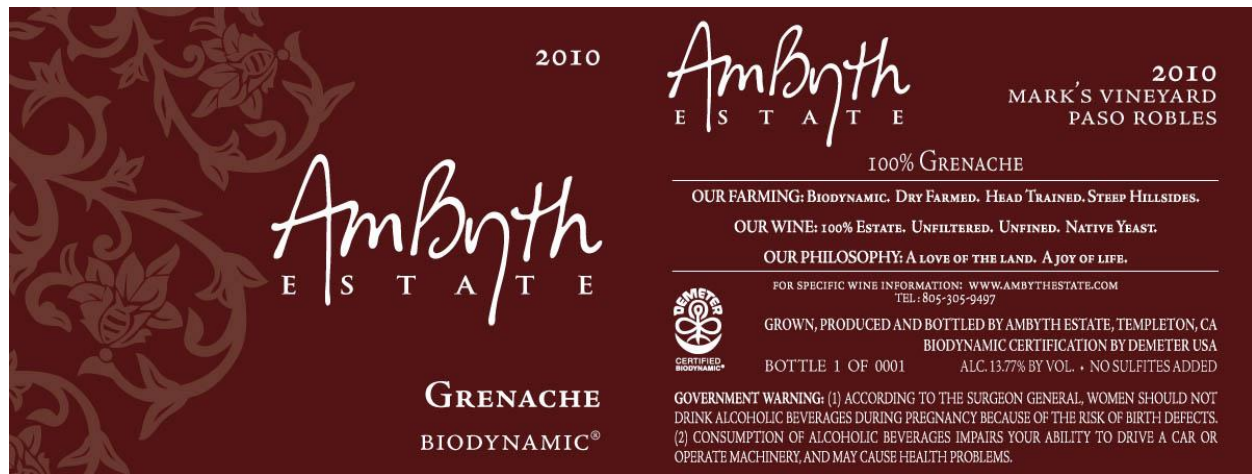


AmByth Grenache 2010

AmByth Estate is a Demeter certified Biodynamic® vineyard farm located in the Templeton Gap. Our vineyards are dry farmed. Our farming is Biodynamic. Our winemaking is natural.



VINEYARDS

The Grenache comes from Mark's Vineyard, a 7 acre south-facing, very steep block on the 42 acre estate vineyard farm. Mark's Vineyard was planted in January 2004, it is 100% dry farmed and trained in goblet style, the spacing is 10' x 10'. Harvesting is by hand, and multiple passes were made through the vineyard, as the upper portions ripen more quickly than the lower vineyard.

TASTING NOTES

Our estate Grenache is beautifully aromatic, with a few gamey notes but strongly mixed with blueberry/cherry and other red fruits; dry tobacco and Indian spices whisper in the background. The palate is intense with red currant and tart berry fruit. The tannins are soft, yet present and well integrated in this medium-bodied wine. The finish is long and clean, carried by a vibrant natural acidity. This wine provides great pleasure and versatility with food pairings and will age gracefully over a decade. Native yeast fermentation, Unfiltered and Unfiltered. 13.77 alc by volume, No Added Sulfites
